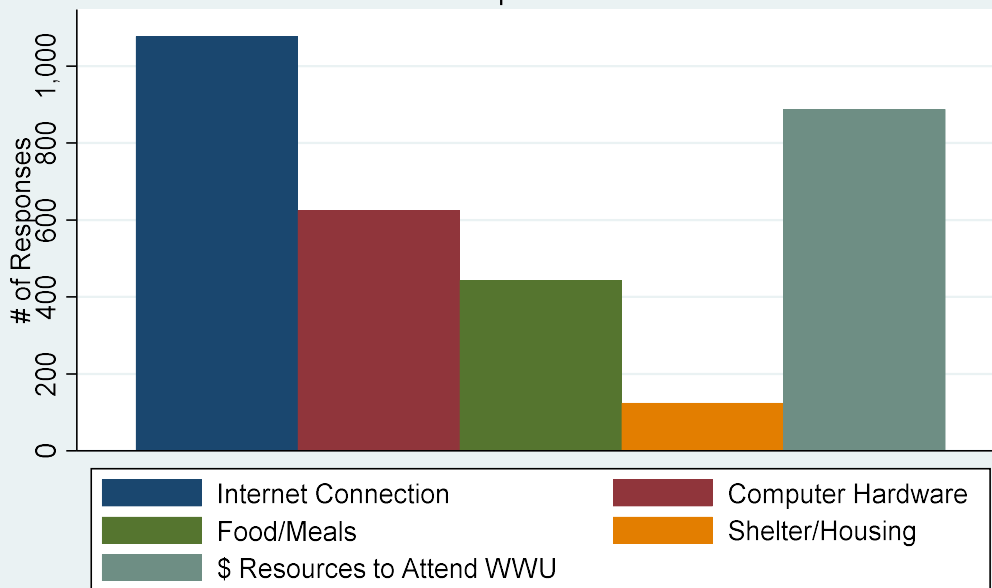
### Did you relocate due to disruption caused by COVID-19?

# of Responses = 5796



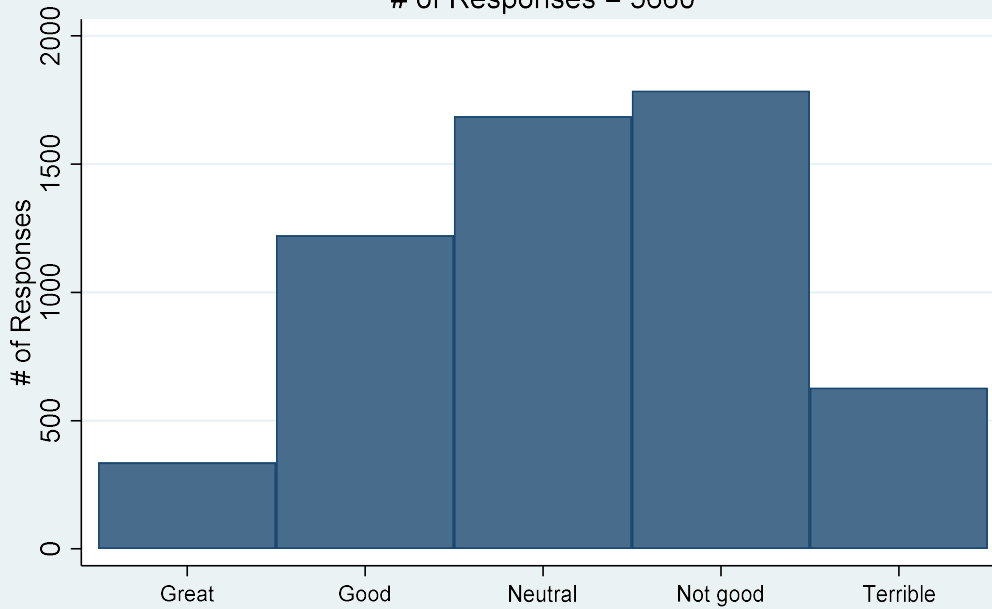
### Which of the following resources are scarce, non-existent, or not reliable for you during spring quarter?

# of Responses = 6394



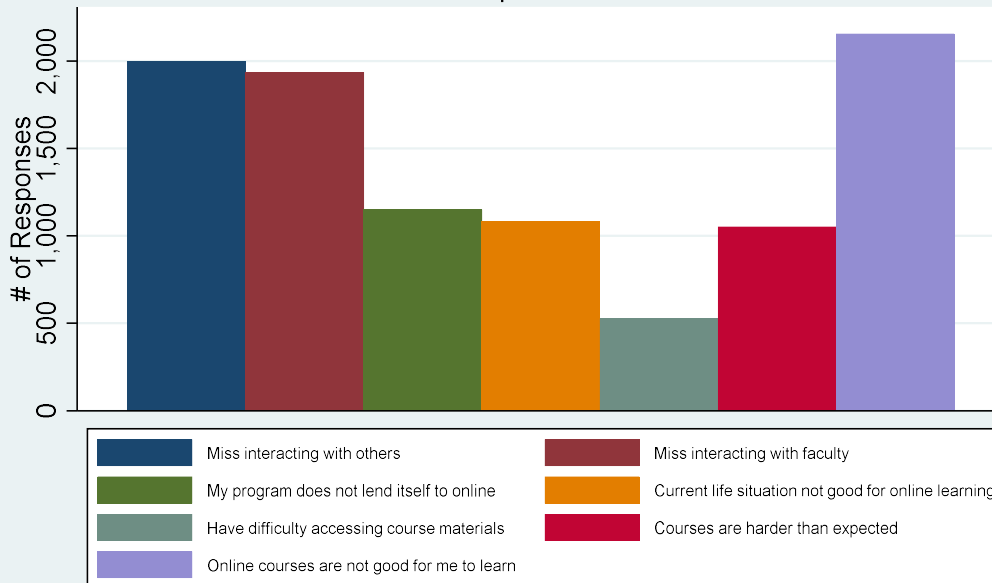
## How would you describe your adjustment to online learning?

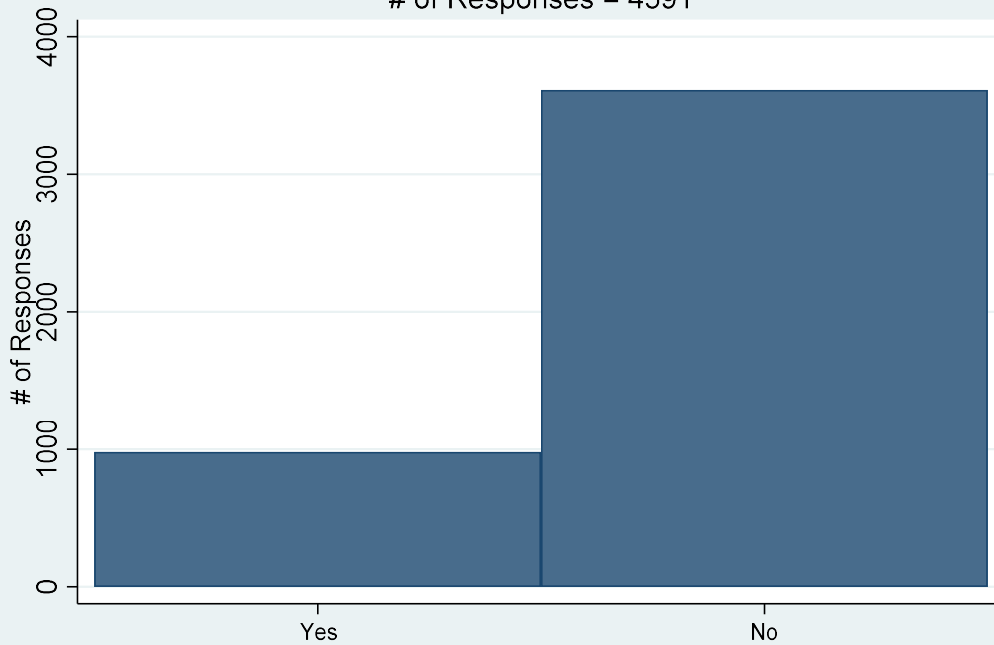
## What has been difficult about the transition to online learning?

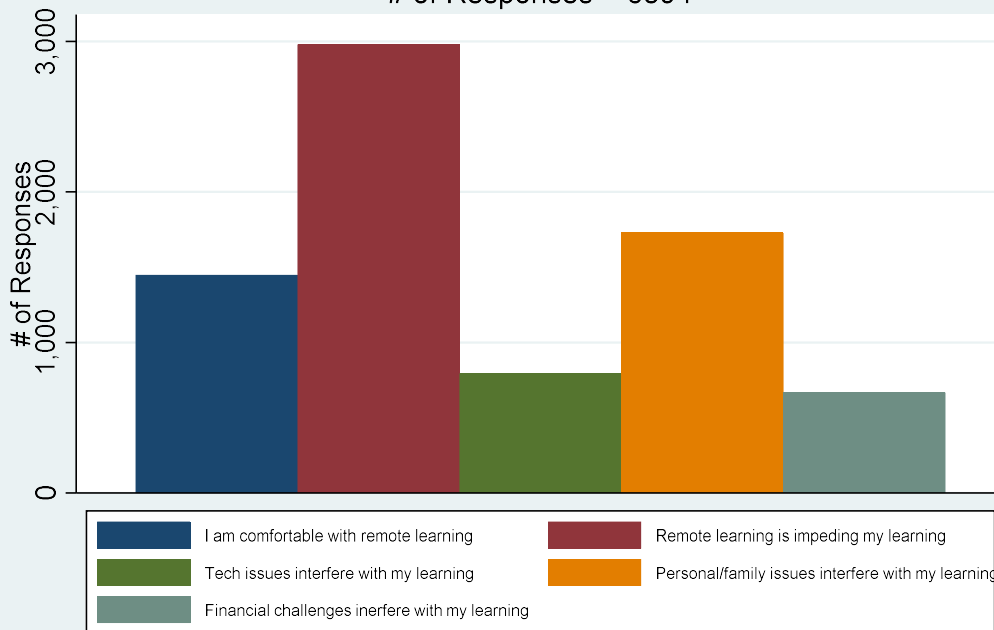
## Did you reduce your course load because of COVID-19?

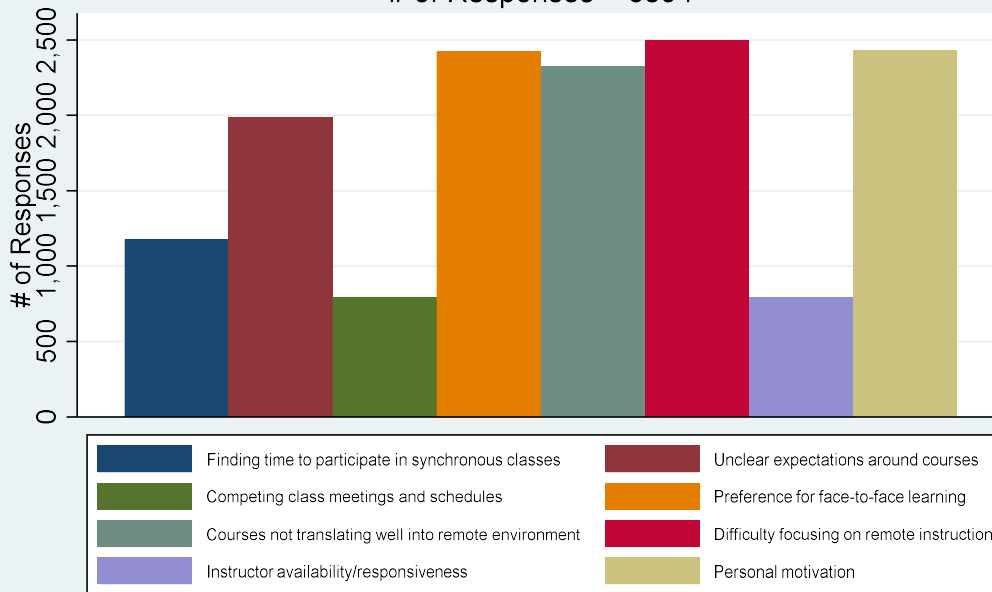
## Which of the following apply to you this spring?

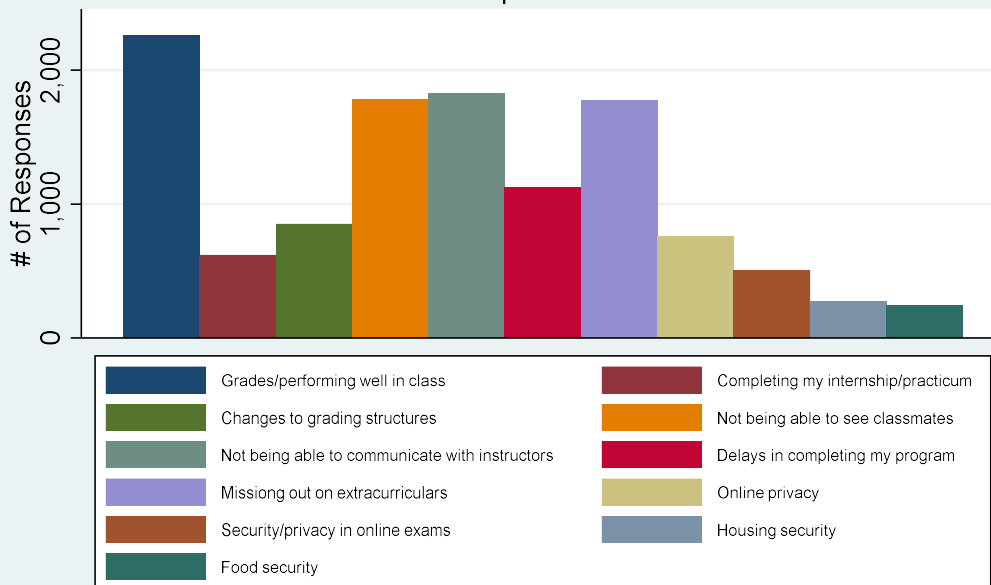
## Which of the following learning issues have been a challenge for you since the transition to remote learning?
